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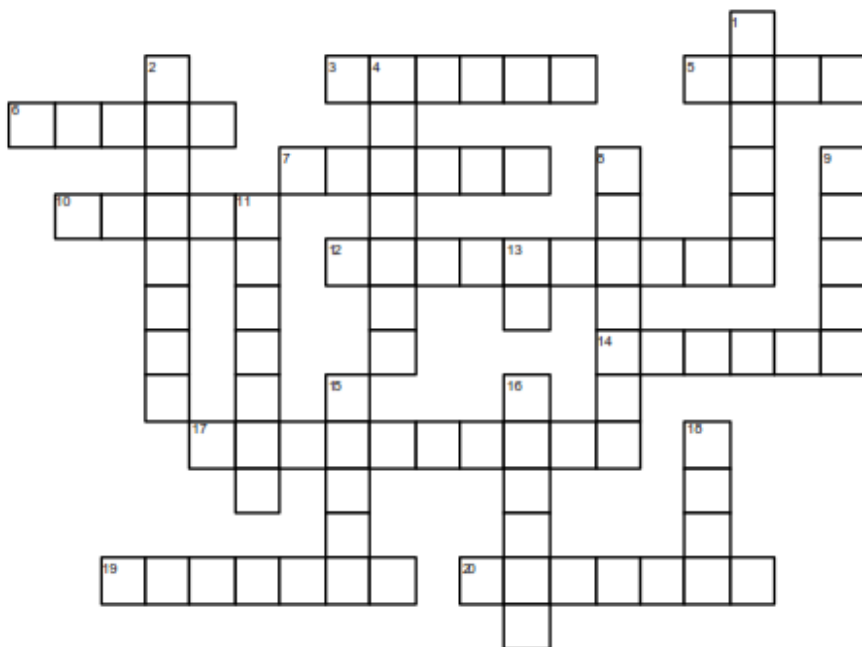

The Pentecost Offering is one of our 4 Special Offerings. It helps children at risk, youth, and young adults to form a strong foundation of faith. Pentecost is the birthday of the Church. It is represented with the color red to symbolize the fire of the Holy Spirit.

Our gifts to the Pentecost Offering connect with God's hope for the future, supporting ministries with children, youth, and young adults by building a life of faith. 40% of our congregational Pentecost Offering stays within our local community. The Peace/Justice/Mission Committee has chosen our portion to go to the Salvation Army Summer Day Camp Program for Needy Children in our area.

These children will be given tutoring, field trips, Bible lessons, crafts, music, meals, and physical activity during the summer. Experiences they wouldn't be able to get otherwise.

The remaining 60% of the Pentecost Offering supports ministries with youth and children at risk as determined by the denomination. Remember, if we all do a little, it adds up to a lot. Please support the future of the Church by giving generously.

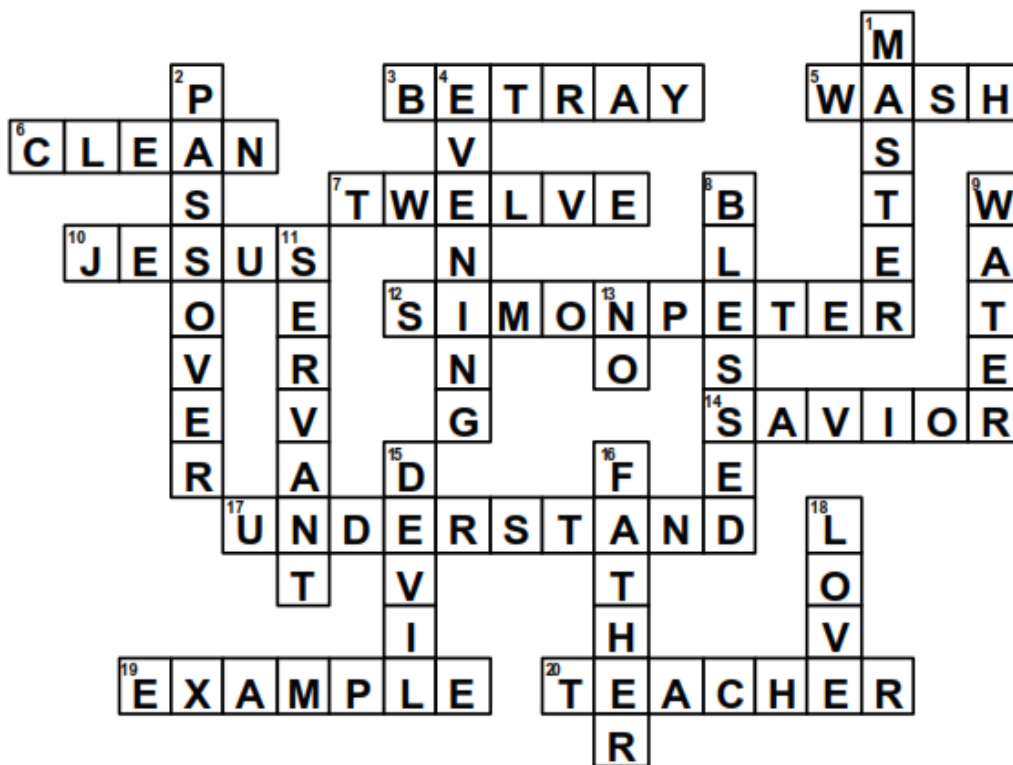
