Gabriela was born in Mexico and her family moved to Arizona when she was 2 years old. She works at a local organization as a Refugee Cash Assistant Supervisor where she aids refugees in receiving support from state benefits. “The most rewarding part of my job is providing refugees with assistance so they can have a better situation in the USA.”

The family of five currently live in a mobile home that has inadequate heating and cooling along with many maintenance issues. While the family enjoys living in a large Hispanic community and usually feel safe, a recent incident next door has increased Gabriela’s concerns about their safety. She learned about Habitat for Humanity Central Arizona from her manager when, while sharing about the lack of heat in her home one winter, her manager suggested she look at Habitat. “Owning a Habitat home would transform the lives of me and my four boys.”

The family is very close and attend church together every Sunday, enjoy music and playing instruments, puzzles, and in their free time enjoy going to Mexico and Rocky Point on short trips. The children are doing well in school with two of them serving on the school counsel where they love to share their thoughts and ideas. Their new home will be a blessing as the boys will be able to find stability and keep friends.
