Welcome to Faith Presbyterian Church

We extend a warm welcome to our Transitional Pastor Greg Emery and his wife, the Honorably Retired Reverend Anne Emery, who have moved from their home in Brownsville, Tennessee to join our Faith Family in Sun City!

Pastor Greg comes to us well prepared. He completed the PCUSA's *Art of Transitional Ministry*, holds a Master's degree in *Theology and Christian Leadership* from Fuller Theological Seminary and a Master's degree in *Business Administration* from Arizona State University.

Pastor Greg recently concluded two-years' service as a CRE (Commissioned Ruling Elder) for a congregation in West Tennessee (Mid-South Presbytery). His church experience includes several years as full-time pastoral staff for three PCUSA churches that he co-guided through a process to form a parish and eventually merge. The new church formed a New Worshipping Community under his leadership.

Pastor Greg also served as chaplain at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis, Scholar-in-Residence for Innovation at an Historically Black College University (HBCU), volunteered in a South African orphanage, and is a cancer survivor.

Recently, Pastor Greg played a unique two-year role as Transitional Pastor to churches in the John Calvin Presbytery (Southern Missouri and Kansas) where he led six churches simultaneously, but individually, through a "visioning" process and, in most cases, preparation to call an installed pastor. This was a one-of-a-kind experiment to serve churches in a focused way where full-time interim/ transitional pastors are in short supply.

A business career in the technology industry with companies such as IBM, Sony and Ampex, as well as numerous start-up ventures, equipped Pastor Greg to address strategic and long-term challenges. Serving primarily as VP of business development or marketing, visiting forty countries, and living in Silicon Valley and numerous spots around the world, has given our Transitional Pastor a wide breadth of exposure to visioning processes and innovative thinking.

These rich and varied experiences allow Pastor Greg to bring real-life stories into his preaching, keeping the message on a spiritual level, addressing our individual roles as Christians and applying the Word to our church and to our lives.

Greg's mother lives in Prescott and daughter, son-in-law and granddaughter live in Phoenix. We welcome Greg and Anne Emery to Faith Presbyterian Church and look forward to meeting members of their family.



FAITH May Newsletter Written April 18, 2024

Greetings new friends in Christ,

I write this elbow deep in boxes, preparing to leave Tennessee and join *y'all* (get used to that) in Arizona, which I consider to be my "home" state. Susan Arnold Recipient of Senior Service Award of the Grand Canyon Presbytery 2024

Susan Arnold received the Presbytery of the Grand Canyon Senior Service Award representing Faith Presbyterian Church. Each year churches in the Synod are asked to nominate one individual for this very special honor of long, faithful service to the church and the community. The awards luncheon and ceremony were recently held at the Desert Palms Presbyterian Church in Sun City West. Susan was joined there by her friend Mary Autio, her brother, Kelly Arnold, and sister-in-law Diane.

Although born in Lewiston, ID she and older brother, Kelley, grew up across the river in Clarkston, Washington attending Clarkston High School. Her mother was a librarian and father an attorney. Susan taught swimming lessons and was a lifeguard in the community for several years.

She attended the University of Idaho receiving a degree in Elementary Education with minors in psychology and history. Her initial years of teaching were in Salem, OR and then she headed north to Redmond, WA, where she taught second and third grades for 31 years. Upon leaving Audubon Elementary a retirement celebration was held with former students, parents, and friends in attendance.

Employing her scholarly talents, Susan spent several years ordering brochures from various retirement areas. She was encouraged to check out Sun City, AZ, did so, and soon bought a home on the golf course.

Shortly after moving to Sun City a neighbor told Susan about the Sun City Visitor Center. Soon she was learning all about her new community. She became an Ambassador, volunteering weekly. She was elected to The Sun City Visitor's Center Board of Directors and served several years in advertising for the Sun City Volunteers. In 2002, she was awarded volunteer of the year.

Living on the golf course encouraged Susan to return to the game. She had been on her high school golf team. Not only did she play golf with the Lakes East Niners, but she also held various volunteer positions in the club. When it came time for tournaments, Susan

was tapped 5 times as volunteer in charge of scorers, scorekeeping, and tournament winners. To this day she remains a member of the Golf Club and twice a year takes part in the service and donations to the Valley View Community Food Bank. In addition, in 2022 Susan was awarded for 20 years of supporting the Sun Health Foundation and the remodeling of the Banner Boswell Emergency Department. Another area of volunteer involvement was with the first Habitat for Humanity Women's Build in El Mirage.

When she moved to Sun City, Susan visited several local churches continuously returning to Faith Presbyterian. She became a member 20 years ago and continues to serve enthusiastically. She has served as a Deacon. For the past 12 years she has been active on the Church Growth and Evangelism committee. She has chaired the committee for the past 8 years. In her role as coordinator of New Member Sunday she organizes the details of that important time in the life of the congregation and members, even arranging for the "line up" as members and sponsors enter the sanctuary! Along with the Pastors, she keeps up with visitors and potential new members. Her committee is also responsible for arranging for volunteers at the Welcome Center and the Greeters at the front door. Each Sunday morning Susan can be seen in the Narthex greeting visitors and members with a welcoming smile. Responsibilities of the chair of the Evangelism Ministry are complex and time consuming!


