

Mary Autio Receives the 2025 Senior Service Award

Mary Autio received this year's Senior Service Award for her long and outstanding service to Faith Presbyterian Church and the community.

Mary, a member since 2004, served on session for 6 years, church growth and evangelism committee for about 20 years, chaired personnel committee, and chaired the nominating committee. She and Susan Arnold organize new member Sundays.

Mary is on the front lines, making sure visitors get to the welcome center, and recognizing repeat visitors. Members say she was the first person they remember meeting at Faith. She seeks out visitors and encourages them to join. One said they stayed with Faith Church because they were welcomed not once, but every Sunday.

*Mary is our cheerleader, with Pom Poms for celebrations.

*When a volunteer is needed for a skit, she'll be there.

*She is the volunteer church photographer. Chances are Mary has taken your picture.

*She is fun to be around.

She volunteers when there's a job that needs doing.

For example, she learned how to operate the livestream cameras and has subbed in the

sound room for Bill and Paul.

On many Sundays, Mary and Susan deliver the cookie jar donations to the finance office after fellowship hour. They also sort through the attendance slips placing visitor slips on top of the stack.

In the community, Mary volunteered for several years at the Sun City Visitors' Center at Bell Rec Center. She is active in the Lakes East Niners golf league, serving on the grounds committee, and twice as president of the Sun City Women's Nine-hole Golf Association.

Mary attended Oregon State University majoring in elementary education. Go Beavers! She taught Kinder-

garten, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th grades and language arts and drama in junior high in Lake Washington School District in Kirkland, Washington. Her favorite musical was Grease. One of her students performed in Sound of Music in Community Theatre. Another student who performed in the Wizard of Oz became a professional actress. For her extraordinary dedication which inspires us to greater service, we are proud to celebrate the 2025 Senior Service Award honoree, Mary Autio.





JANUARY

The date of March 4, 2025, for the Annual meeting was approved.

Pastor Greg said the Visioning Process sub teams had been formed to explore the different possibilities for Faith church going forward. The teams are meeting weekly.

FEBRUARY

A motion from Personnel to approve the renewal of Pastor Greg's contract, which comes due in May, for another year was approved.


When a teenager vanishes from her Adirondack summer camp, two worlds collide.
